Hall of Fame Criteria

The Hall of Fame is in place to recognize those that have made a significant contribution to Lethbridge & District Exhibition.

- This contribution could have been made for the benefit of an Exhibition Park event, a more general corporate contribution, or a significant effort to improve the position of Exhibition Park in the City of Lethbridge and/or Southern Alberta.
- The Hall of Fame award would be granted each year at the Annual General Meeting, or such other appropriate time as may be approved by the Board of Directors.
- The award does not necessarily have to be granted annually.
- Likewise, more than one recipient can be awarded in a single year.
- Those eligible for consideration include all Shareholders, volunteers, and Board Directors and members of the general public that have made a substantial and significant contribution to Exhibition Park.
- Consideration of individual candidates is to include, but is not limited to: length of service, a specific contribution of benefit, and/or an ongoing effort to reflect Exhibition Park positively to the City of Lethbridge and Southern Alberta.
- All applications will require the signatures of three co-signers who support the applicant in his/her recommendation.
- The award shall be an 8 ½ x 11 color photograph appropriately displayed in an area within the facilities at Exhibition Park.
- A plaque commemorating the Hall of Fame award shall also be presented to the recipient.
- The Shareholder Committee of the Board shall review recommendations of individuals to the Hall of Fame. These reviews shall come in the form of a written nomination using the Nomination Form, as approved by the Shareholder Committee. Completed forms are to be submitted to the Shareholder committee no later than June 30th of each year.
- The Committee shall review all nominations annually with any deserving candidates presented to the Board of Directors for approval. The President of the Board of Lethbridge & District Exhibition will contact successful candidates and confirm their receipt of the award.
- The candidate will also receive written confirmation.
